

## **Notice of Natural England's Coastal Access Report: East Cowes Ferry to Wootton Bridge (Isle of Wight 1).**

On 27<sup>th</sup> August 2025 Natural England submitted a coastal access report to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs under section 51 of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act 1949 pursuant to its duty under section 296(1) of the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009. The reports relate to the coast between East Cowes Ferry and Wootton Bridge.

This notice is being given to you as a person or body listed in paragraph 2(2)(b) to (e) of Schedule 1A to the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act 1949, or as a person or body listed in Schedule 1 to the Coastal Access Reports (Consideration and Modification Procedure) (England) Regulations 2010 (S.I. 2010/1976).

If the proposals in the report are approved in their current form by the Secretary of State, the public will be able to exercise rights of access under section 2(1) of the Countryside and Rights of Way Act 2000 for open-air recreation on foot along the English coastal route as set out in the reports and over the area of associated coastal margin. These rights are subject to any exceptions (for example gardens) or restrictions set out in that Act or proposed in the reports (once approved).

You are invited to make representations about this report. Any representations must be made on the form which can be found on the website and must be received by Natural England no later than midnight on 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2025.
