#### Discussion was held:

- more residents negative towards fireworks due to effects on pets and wildlife
- large jump in funds when not enough in the PC's budget
- Council used to fund the fireworks but the event was taken over by BYCC
- donation buckets have helped towards funds
- should ask local businesses to help fund
- do not need to have super bang fireworks, there are quieter ones available

**080/21/03** To consider, discuss and agree contents of response to the Draft Island Planning Strategy Discussion was held:

• this is the consultation for the extension of the settlement boundary

- extension to the village will make a huge difference in terms of the pressure on infrastructure roads, traffic, schools, flooding, medical services, sewage
- negates what Bembridge needs better infrastructure, affordable housing,
- have been told that infrastructure will only come at planning stage
- need to be proactive on planning, what do we need in the village?
- the BCM proposal of 56 houses is below the level when improvements to infrastructure is a condition
- affordability, homes need to remain affordable with a clear definition of affordability
- why are we being changed from a Rural Service Area to a Secondary Settlement, no extra facilities or infrastructure
- concerns for the flood risks in Bembridge
- with extra housing there is no mention of extra transport
- need to mention the Biosphere, effects on climate change and AONB areas
- should look at Community Land Trusts and Housing Trusts
