## 3. Minutes of the previous meeting of the Community Matters Committee

#### 4. Finance

After some discussion it was agreed to check the original committee budget and to remove the £200 expenditure from the community chest event for Right at Home as this money should have come from the small grants budget line.

#### 5. Bembridge Star Competition

Judges are going to be Cllr S Noyes, R Poncia & P Kenny. The judging will take place at 5pm on 2 days: 14<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> December 2023. Prizes will be awarded in 3 categories: best home, best charity and best commercial property. Max amount in the prize fund £100 in case of a tie in any category. Presentation will be at the Friendship Circle Coffee morning on 6<sup>th</sup> January 2024.

### 6. Bembridge Mural

After some discussion it was decide to: pressure hose the current mural in the spring to clean it up; Set up a working group to move this forward in January; Create a competition to design a new mural; Ask the art society if they would be prepared to paint the winning design. The wall will need to be whitewashed before the winning design can be painted.

#### 7. Bembridge Map

After discussion it was agreed to: front page whole page picture bleeding to edges; boxes for the bit pictures with a 12<sup>th</sup> box for answers; add a blue background; add PC logo to front page; ask the printers to set it up from the photos so maximum coverage is achieved; add Produced by BPC & printed by Desktop Studios; get a print run of 2000.

#### 8. D-Day 80th Anniversary 6th June 2024

A briefing note was sent out. In addition, David Mears (NT) has confirmed it is in the diary; A list of veteran organisations has been acquired; Choir and pianist from Brading confirmed; Rev S Daughtery confirmed; scouts are keen to help although it is a school night; Kevin is sorting traffic management. #### 9. Community Chest

Very successful event. More children present would be appreciated; consider moving the timing into September so it is lighter in the evening. It would be good to see pictures of the things we have helped groups to achieve; ask for some photos.

#### 10. Have Your Say Day

There was a steady stream of people; morning works better; displays looked good. Next year organise for Sept or Oct to try and get better weather.

An analysis of the last 3 years of comments shows that most of our residents agree that the important issues are: planning, infrastructure, flooding, traffic, and the need for a school crossing.
